

**COVID-19 PROCEDURES  
CAR CLUB & RENTALS  
ISSUED 07-03-2020**

The following procedures are in accordance to established guidelines by The Government of Quebec.

**EACH PARTICIPANT & GUEST** attending a track day must respect the following before arrival:

1. If you are considered "high risk" stay home
2. If you feel sick before arriving stay home
3. If you do not feel safe participating at events which permit public gathering stay home
4. Is willing to respect all procedural and social practice guidelines.

If you start to feel sick while at the track, notify your Club Director/President and go home. A non-contact infrared forehead thermometer will be available for testing. It is the responsibility of the Club Director/President to report any participants or guests who feel sick to Circuit Mont Tremblant Management.

**EACH PARTICIPANT & GUEST** attending a track day must bring:

1. Face mask
2. Hand sanitizer
3. Any additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) they feel necessary

**PROCEDURES: ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION**

The circuit reserves the right to pre-designate paddock spaces and other areas.

CLUB DIRECTOR/PRESIDENT – must provide Circuit Mont Tremblant management with a complete list of participants, car numbers, car descriptions and their guests 48h before the start of the event.

CLUB DIRECTOR/PRESIDENT – will be responsible to control/limit the number of persons permitted on site as established by the Government of Quebec.

TRACK WAIVER & ACCESS BRACELET – There will be no paperwork processed at the Chemin Seguin entrance. All participants and their guests will have to pass registration in advance. Only registered participants and guests wearing an access bracelet will be permitted via this gate.

REGISTRATION – The tracks registration office will be available to clubs via the Chemin du Village (spectators) entrance from 07h00-16h00 to carry out their registration. Everyone will be required to wear a protective face mask, and respect social distancing.

PARKING IN THE PADDOCK – a participant's truck/trailer/awning set up must have a minimum distance of 5 meters (15ft) between the next nearest participants' truck/trailer/awning set up.

ALL PARTICIPANTS & THEIR GUESTS - must practice social distancing at all times and not stand closer than 2 meters (6ft) apart.

**WEARING A PROTECTIVE FACE MASK** is an additional measure to protect others.

It is not about getting the infection. It is about not spreading the infection. As a result:

1. ALL PARTICIPANTS & THEIR GUESTS – Must wear a protective face mask, when venturing outside their own designated paddock space, visiting the restrooms and/or whenever a 2 meter (6ft) separation is not possible.
2. ALL PARTICIPANTS & THEIR GUESTS - must maintain distance and wear a protective face mask within their own designated paddock space when more than one (1) person is present

ALL PARTICIPANTS & THEIR GUEST – are discouraged from roaming the paddock and/or socializing with others without practicing social distancing.

PASSENGERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to ride in a car at any time.

**PROCEDURES: TRAILER DROP-OFF, CAMPERS, RESTROOMS & CAFETERIA PROCEDURES**

TRAILER DROP-OFF – Participants must receive permission from Circuit Mont Tremblant management prior to dropping their trailer in advance of an event. The participant will need to verify when drop off is permitted and submit the name of the person arriving with the trailer. Drop-off will be defined as unhook and go, no set up, no socializing, no loitering.

NOTE: Restroom facilities will be closed when you arrive.

CONTROL TOWER – will be closed. An administrative tent located in the paddock will be available for club use. Protective face masks and social distancing will be required in the tent.

STAGING – Clubs will be required to provide their own staff for staging.

RESTROOM FACILITIES (CONTROL TOWER) – will be open to one (1) person at a time. You will be required to wear a face mask. Follow posted directions, sanitary procedures and respect social distancing guidelines at all times.

RESTROOM FACILITIES (PODIUM) – will be closed.

CAFETERIA & FOOD – The cafeteria will be closed to walk up service. Pre-order and delivery / pick up service may be available on demand. Communal food and beverages are NOT PERMITTED in the paddock and/or administration tent (i.e. Tim Horton's coffee, doughnuts, water / beverage coolers etc...)

CONCLUSION OF THE DAY – Post day gatherings are not permitted. Upon completion of your last session please pack your belongs and leave the facility.

TRASH / GARBAGE – All participants & their guests are required to take their trash with them

MOTORHOMES / RVs / TRAVEL TRAILERS – will be accepted in the paddock as of July 6, 2020 for confirmed, registered participants. Overnight security will be in place for those intending to stay overnight in the paddock either the night before an event, the nights between multiple day events or following an event if prearranged with Circuit Mont-Tremblant and a security fee will be charged nightly for this. Permission must be received in advance from Circuit Mont-Tremblant management and participants must submit the name(s) and a signed ACCEPTANCE OF RISK waiver of each person staying in the unit 2 days in advance. We will accept either a scan or .pdf of this document (no photo) by email only. Waivers will not be accepted at the gate. Participants and/or guests who have not registered in advance will not be permitted entry.

Motorhomes / RVs / Travel Trailers will be permitted entry from 6:00pm to 7:00pm unless otherwise prearranged with Circuit Mont-Tremblant. Gates to the paddock will close at 7:00pm each night unless prearranged with Circuit Mont-Tremblant.

Motorhomes / RVs / Travel Trailers must be self-contained and equipped with a washroom. Restroom facilities at Circuit Mont-Tremblant will close at 5:00pm each day.

Overnight occupation is limited only to persons who reside at the same address. Any gathering is limited to a maximum of 10 persons from a maximum of three (3) households.

A minimum physical distance of 2 meters (6ft) must be maintained between people who do not come from the same household otherwise the number of guests must be reduced.

Wearing masks is required when it is not possible to maintain a distance of 2 meters (6ft) with other people.
